What is McDonald's Taste for Work?

THE COMMUNICATION CHALLENGE

The Communication Challenge has been designed to specifically help your child develop their speaking and listening skills, and to build their confidence while preparing them for their first job.



During the challenge, students will work in teams to complete series of communication-based tasks set in the workplace. The challenge culminates in students creating an elevator pitch sharing their strengths in speaking, how they have developed the skill and how these examples show they are ready for work.

Tasks are set through videos of McDonald's employees who also share their skills and expertise, giving students an additional insight into the world of work.

The challenge has been created by education experts and with support from Skills Builder (a recognised body that focus on helping young people unlock learning in the classroom through essential skills development). The challenge puts a focus on helping students to develop appropriate speaking skills and applying different types of language (formal, informal and technical) to scenarios in the workplace.
